

GOVERNOR NEEDS TO REPRIMAND OFFICIALS DURING PPKM MEETING

MANOKWARI, papuabaratusnews.co - Ombudsman Representative of West Papua asks the Governor of West Papua to give a warning to government officials who held a meeting during PPKM. This is considered as a form of defiance against the Governor's policy regarding the provision of government activities that have the potential to gather people in large numbers.

"Today there is a meeting held by the Provincial Office in the Hotel Aston. It cannot be allowed," said the Head of the Representative Ombudsman of West Papua Musa Yosep Sombuk in Manokwari, Thursday (5/8/2021).

According to Musa, the Governor needs to evaluate the officials who organized the activity. Because the government should give an example that can be followed by the community during the restriction of activities.

"Very disappointing, because officials give an example that is not good," said he.

He said, every government activity during PPKM can be done through online. Because with holding a meeting, it will cause a perception that is biased from the community regarding the restriction of activities that are currently running. So it cannot be blamed if the community then reacts that PPKM is only implemented towards the community.

"This is a conscious effort by them to break the rules made by the Governor of West Papua," said Musa.

He gave a challenge to the Governor to evaluate especially his subordinates who held the activity. Because it is a deliberate effort to break the rules or the superior's command.

"I challenge the Governor of West Papua to take disciplinary action against his subordinates. So there is a warning," he said. (PB25)
